CAO Recruitment

Central Elgin Municipal Council has approved Wendell Graves for the interim role of CAO/Clerk by resolution, with the contract scheduled to commence on March 30, 2023. Alongside this decision, Council has directed the Human Resources staff to initiate the recruitment process to permanently fill the position of CAO/Clerk. Additionally, a committee consisting of two or three Council members will be appointed by April 12, 2023, to assist in the hiring process and provide hiring recommendations to the Council.



Edward Street Right-of-Way

Ms. Margo Jory of Port Stanley and Emma Tamblyn spoke to the Council representing their community of Orchard Beach, expressing their support for the construction of stairs between Edward Street Right-of-Way and Prospect Street as well as the historical significance of the project.



Noise Exemption Harbour Dredging

Council passed a resolution declaring that the permitting of a 24-hour dredging operation for the 2023 Port Stanley Harbour dredge would be financially beneficial to the residents of Central Elgin. As a result, a noise exemption will be granted for the project from July 1, 2023 to January 1, 2024, allowing for uninterrupted dredging operations around the clock.
